

Cancer Institute (WIA) Chennai is one of the leading Cancer Institutes in India with a track record of 6 decades. It has been a pioneer in the area of cancer care and control. Cancer Institute (WIA) is unique in that, it is a non-government, voluntary charitable institution providing either totally free or highly subsidized treatment to over 60% of its patients, the only one of its kind in India. Of the total 500 beds, only 40% are paying. The Cancer Institute (WIA) provides state of art treatment to all patients, paying or non-paying (free). The protocols of treatment are no different – all are the same. There is no class divide.

Cancer of the cervix & breast constitutes nearly 50% of all cancers in women. Breast cancer is increasing. Chemotherapy contributes a major component of breast cancer care. The protocol used in majority of patients is FEC, either neoadjuvant or adjuvant.

The Maina Foundation has kindly agreed to support chemotherapy for 20 breast cancer patients (6 cycles of FEC) annually towards the underprivileged.
